





Manage light, heat and save energy.

Made of durable, vinyl-coated polyester fabric, our shades are available in a variety of colors and openness levels, from 0–5%.*

- · Openness refers to the weave structure, which determines the amount of light and heat that penetrates the fabric.
- Smaller percentages have a tighter fabric weave and block out the light for less glare—appropriate for patient rooms and exam rooms.
- · Higher percentages have a looser weave to allow more light, heat and outward visibility—ideal for lobbies, offices and common areas.
- · Blackout fabrics provide total light elimination.
- · Fire-retardant¹; easy-to-clean with mild detergent or dry sponge.
